1. Study and deliberations on fundamental and comprehensive policies on the use, development and conservation of the national land, in response to the request for consultation from the Minister of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism.
2. Handling of matters under the jurisdiction of the Council under the provisions of the National Spatial Planning Act, National Land Use Planning Act, National Capital Region Development Act, Act to Preserve the Suburban Green Zones in the National Capital Region, Kinki Region Development Act, Act concerning the Development of suburban Development and Redevelopment Areas and Urban Development Areas in the Kinki Region, Act concerning the Development of Natural Reserve Areas in Kinki Region, Act concerning the Development of Urban Improvement Areas, Urban Development Areas and Natural Reserve Areas in Chubu Region, Hokkaido Development Act, Basic Act for Land, Public Notice of Land Prices Law, National Land Survey Act, Act on Special Measures for Promotion for National Land Survey, Water Resources Development Promotion Act, Act on Special Measure for promotion for Industrial Development in Underdeveloped Areas and Act of Special Concerning Heavy Snowfall Areas.
