The Results of the Air Transport Joint Seminar between the Social Republic of Vietnam and Japan

- ✓ On December 18, 2015, the Air Transport Joint Seminar was held in Hanoi, Vietnam with the State Minister of Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism (MLIT), Toru Doi in attendance. The seminar was hosted by the Council for the International Development of Aviation Infrastructure (CIDAI) as a project through public-private partnerships.
- ✓ This is the third overseas seminar in the same style, with attendance of about 180 persons from both countries.
- ✓ MLIT State Minister, Toru Doi had bilateral talks with the Deputy Minister of Transport, Nguyen Van Cong.

2. Main Topics

At the seminar, the representatives of Japan gave presentations regarding the development of a new airport in the metropolitan area and modernization of air traffic

management technology following the opening remarks by the Deputy Minister of Transport, Nguyen Nhat and MLIT State Minister, Toru Doi.

The representatives of Vietnam made presentations regarding its civil aviation policies and aviation infrastructure projects in the planning process. The Vietnamese participants expressed keen interest in the suggestions made by Japan.

3. Results of the Bilateral Talks

On the same day, MLIT State Minister, Toru Doi had bilateral talks with the Deputy Minister of Transport, Nguyen Van Cong to promote the sales in the aviation market by himself, while Mr. Cong expressed his gratitude for Japan's efforts and concluded by saying that he is expecting further collaboration with Japan. They agreed that both countries will take forward the dialogue in the transport sector including aviation sector to best maintain close partnership.

- In April 2013, with the aim of pushing forward with international development of aviation infrastructure through PPP (public-private-partnership), trading firms, constructors, airport companies, manufacturers, financial institutions, relevant bodies and others have jointly established the Council.
