Function

- This app provides disaster information to international visitors. The Japan Tourism Agency launched the app in October 2014 with
 the aim of achieving an environment in which international visitors can travel around Japan a country that experiences a number of
 natural disasters with a feeling of greater security.
- · It is available in five languages: English, Simplified Chinese, Traditional Chinese, Korean and Japanese.
- It provides push notifications of Earthquake Early Warnings, Tsunami Warnings, Weather Warnings and Eruption Notices issued in Japan. In addition, there is an action flowchart and a communication card, along with useful links that provide information in times of disaster.





The display language can be changed on "Setting" in the app




Seismic intensities near the epicenter are shown


