

Sakata Yume no Kura (Sankyo Rice torehouse)

Sakata Yume no Kura comprises of 2 out of 12 buildings of Sankyo Rice Storehouse, which was erected in 1893 and still stores agricultural products today. The facility offers an array of souvenirs, a café, a restaurant, and a museum. The museum displays a spectacular hanging decoration called "Kamekasahoko" crafted in 1834 by order of the wealthy merchant family Honma and sells various folk handicrafts.

Kamo Aquarium



The Three Mountains of Dewa (Dewasanzan) consist of Mt. Haguro, Mt. Gassan and Mt. Yudono. It is said that the mountains represent current life (Haguro), previous life (Gassan) and future life (Yudono), respectively. The Dewasanzan pilgrimage represents a journey of reincarnation, where people enter from Mt. Haguro, dedicate themselves to spiritual practice at Mt. Gassan and undergo a pilgrimage to be reborn at Mt. Yudono. Mt. Haguro's avenue of cedars has a three-star rating in the Michelin Guide.

Sokushinbutsu is self-mummified Buddhist monks, or living Buddha, who underwent austere mountain asceticism to eliminate body fat and bodily fluids for preventing from rotting and preserve their bodies "forever." This practice was done to pray for the people's salvation. Sokushinbutsu embodies those monks' prayer for people's "eternal" happiness. Most of the Sokushinbutsu in Japan are enshrined in temples in Yamagata prefecture.
