## Osaka-Castle

Main Attractions

This huge castle was built as a symbol of the authority of *Toyotomi Hideyoshi*. It was burned down during the summer campaign of the Siege of Osaka. The keep, which was rebuilt by *Tokugawa Iemitsu*, later burned down again after being struck by lightning. The current keep was rebuilt in 1931 atop a stone wall from the Edo-era and was financed with citizen donations. The inside is a museum where important cultural properties and other precious historic documents are placed on display.

## World Heritage "Mozu-Furuichi Kofun Group" and Japanese Heritage "Takenouchi Kaido / Yokooji (Oji highway)"

Covers the oldest history of Japanese tombs and public road."Mozu-Furuichi Kofun Group" was officially registered as World Cultural Heritage In 2019, and in 2017, "Takenouchi Kaido / Yokooji" that is Japan's oldest public road from Namba to Asuka was recognized as Japan Heritage. Visitors can feel not only the changes of 1,400 years of history through the historical sites nearby but also the cityscape that lasts 1,400 years, including Imai-cho in Kashihara, where many old private houses still exist.
