Kintaikyo Bridge

Main Attractions

This bridge was first built in 1673 by KikkawaHiroyoshi, the third-generation feudal lord of Iwakuni. The current bridge was constructed by the fourth-generation feudal lord. A wooden bridge with five arches, it straddles the clear waters of the Nishiki River and measures 193.3 meters long and 5 meters wide. It is constructed by a combination of wood and C-shaped hoop iron girder binders, and clamps are used.

Kashiwabara Art Museum

Located a 10 minutes' walk from Kintaikyo Bridge, Kashiwabara Art Museum exhibits a collection of ancient armor and weapons that is among the best in Japan. The collection of approximately 6,000 items includes porcelain ware, glass crafts, calligraphy, armor, swords, battle coats, and harnesses dating from the Nara Period to the Edo Period. Approximately 200 items are on permanent display, including the Battle of Kawanakashima and Battle Array of the Takeda Army 8-part folding screens. The museum earned a star in the Michelin Green Guide Japan.
