## "The Village of the Secret Kilns" Okawachiyama

Main Attractions

Surrounded by mountains in three directions, Okawachiyama is known as "Hiyonosato (Village of the Secret Kilns)". Between 1675 and the abolition of the clan system in 1871, the kiln for the Nabeshima (Saga) Clan was located in Okawachiyama. Pottery of superb quality given as gifts to the Imperial courts and Shogun families were made there. Today, the pottery is considered a world treasure and called by the name "Nabeshima."
