
# Sunset Way

# Hirado Castle

Main Attractions

Hirado Castle, also known as Kameoka Castle, is built on the hill of flatland protruding into the Strait of Hirado. The original castle, then called Hinotake Castle, was erected in 1599 by MatsuraShigenobu (29th Lord), who burned down the structure himself in 1613. With assistance from military strategist YamagaSoko, Matsura Takashi (30th) designed the present-day castle in 1704, and construction was completed in 1718 by MatsuraAtsunobu (31st), who named it Kameoka Castle.
