
IZUMI-CHA -Green tea from Izumi-

By Public Transport


Main Attractions

Shohinken was built by Naoyuki Matsui, the feudal lord of Yatsushiro Castle, for his mother in 1688.

The Akajogaike pond and the Akajogamori grove are incorporated as they are into the garden with the simple and majestic background of Mt.Aso to the Uto Peninsula and Unzen Volcano.

This is popular among people as the "teahouse on the seashore" and has been designated as a national scenic site.

Gokanosho

Main Attractions

Gokanosho is a collective name for five villages-- Hagi, Momigi, Shiibaru, Kureko, and Nitao-- and is referred to as the secluded land of Kyushu. Gokanosho, located in the center of Kumamoto Prefecture, is a mountainous area with a poetic atmosphere where the Sugawara legend and the fleeing Heike warrior legend are passed on. Rich forests and deep ravines surround Mt. Kunimidake, the highest mountain (1,739 m) in Kumamoto. In particular, the 70-meter high Sendantodoro Falls, and the beautiful autumn leaves are popular tourist attractions.

The autumn festival of Yatsushiro Shrine (former Myoken-gu) which was designated as Intangible Cultural Heritage by UNESCO, is one of Kyushu's three major festivals and continued without interruption for more than 380 years. About 1700 people join this festival as the guards of "Mikoshi" which the god inhabits, and as comforters of the god. They march in procession around the city area in a distance of 6 kilometers. The parade showcases an elaborate display, which includes 40 programs for attracting people, such as the heroic "Shishimai" (Lion Dance), an imaginary animal called as "Kida", and 9 sets of gorgeous "Kasaboko" (Decorative Portable Shrine), and so on. It is well worth seeing, and the energetic and dynamic performance fascinates a large audience every year.

Yatsushiro National Fireworks Competition

This is the only national fireworks festival in Kyushu where 30 famous pyrotechnicians from Akita in northern Japan to Kagoshima in southern Japan compete against each other through displays of skilled fireworks. As each firework gets displayed, the names of the creators and an explanation of their work are announced. Shooting up over 500 meters into the sky are uniquely concocted bottle rockets; such as ones measuring 400-meter in diameter, and ones with music, etc. More than 150,000 spectators from all over Japan and various parts of Kumamoto make their way to Yatsushiro for this event. The city overflows with bustling crowd on the 3rd Saturday of October every year.

The Toyo Stone Takumi Museum contains Japan-Heritage certified relics of the masons who created Yatsushiro

The Toyo Stone Takumi Museum is a museum of masonry and arched bridges located in Toyo Town in Yatsushiro City. This area, which was once called Taneyama, was well-known for Taneyama Masonry. A number of arched bridges, including the Tsujun Bridge were built using this kind of masonry. There are still 21 arched bridges in Toyo Town which have survived over a century of wind and snow. In 2020 the "Relics of the stone masons who created Yatsushiro" received a Japan Heritage Designation.
