Goto Udon Noodles

Some accounts say that Goto Tenobe Udon Noodles were brought back by envoys from the continent. The slender noodles have body and go down smoothly. The locals usually eat it "jigoku-daki" style, which means the noodles are boiled in a large pot and taken with chopsticks directly from the pot and dipped in sauce made from flying fish stock or a mixture of raw egg and soy sauce.

Kashiragashima Church

This stone church is unique in all Japan, having been built with sandstone cut from around the church by believers that returned to the island after the persecution ended. In contrast to the stately exterior, the interior has a gentle atmosphere created by a coved ceiling and floral patterns. Construction on the current church building began in 1910 and was completed in 1917. as World Cultural Heritage site.

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Christian's Cave

This cave is 50 meters deep and is located on a precipitous cliff in the southwestern part of Wakamatsu Island. Christians of Wakamatsu Island and Satonoura hid themselves in this steep cliff that could only be reached by boat in order to avoid persecution during the crackdown of Goto, but the smoke from their breakfast cooking was discovered by passing boats, and they were captured and tortured. In 1967 a 3-meter statue of Christ was placed at the entrance.

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Oso Church

The descendants of Christians who moved from Shitsu, Kurosaki, Ikeshima and other areas of Sotome are said to live in Oso. A wooden church was built in 1879, and in 1916 the current brick church was completed. The old building was moved to Doinoura in the Wakamatsu area. There is a belfry on the octagonal dome roof, and the walls are constructed of two different types of bricks of different colors.
