2. Agenda

The conference was held under the main theme of enhancing transport security while realizing smooth and efficient transportation. Individual sessions were held for each sector.

- (1) Maritime security
- (2) Aviation security
- (3) Land transport security

3. Findings

A "Ministerial Statement" was adopted for each of the three sessions.

In the first day of the Conference, ministers responsible for transport security from major countries exchanged views and information to secure transport security and discussed vigorously. As a result, as can be seen in the Ministerial Statements that they adopted, ministers were unanimous in their commitment to greater international cooperation and coordination to secure and enhance transport security.
