- 1. Applies to: Kawasaki BK117 Series Helicopters: S/N 1001 through 1006 and 1008 through 1014
- 2. Compliance required as indicated, unless already accomplished.

To prevent possible malfunction of check valve of fire extinguishing system due to improper location of rodretainer, accomplish the following:

Within 50 flight hours or one month after the effective date of this AD, whichever occurs first, inspect check valve (P/N 35200100) of engine fire extinguishing system for proper location of rod-retainer in accordance with Kawasaki Service Bulletin KSB-117-035A dated June 30, 1987 or later JCAB approved revisions.

An unacceptable check valve must be replaced with a serviceable one, prior to further flight.

Alternate means of compliance with this AD may be used, if approved by Director-General of Japan Civil Aviation Bureau.
