- 2. Compliance required as indicated, unless already accomplished.

To prevent detachment of the balance weight from the main rotor blade which could result in extraordinary vibration, accomplish the followings;

2.1 Perform an inspection and, if necessary, replace main rotor blades with serviceable ones at the time described in the paragraph 2.1.1 and 2.1.2, and thereafter repeat the

inspection at intervals not to exceed 50 flight hours, in accordance with Kawasaki BK117 Service Bulletin KSB-117-115-1 dated February 17, 2000 or JCAB-approved later revision.

- 2.1.1 Within 5 flight hours after the effective date of this AD.
- 2.1.2 For the used main rotor blades which are held as spares, before re-installation on the rotorcraft.
- 2.2 An alternative means of compliance with this AD may be used, if approved by the Director-General of JCAB.
