## Airworthiness Directive

The undermentioned examinations or modifications are mandatory.

- 1. Applies to: NAMC Model YS-11/-11A Series Airplanes
- 2. Compliance required as indicated

To prevent the possible loss of emergency electrical power, prior to the first flight after July 20, 1979 0 A.M. (JST), and thereafter at the intervals not to exceed 7 calendar days, accomplish the followings;

- 2.1 Inspect the batteries, in accordance with NAMC YS-11 Maintenance Manual or YS-11A Maintenance Manual 24-30-3 "Battery Inspection" section.
- 2.2 Check the terminal voltage of each battery cell for abnormal voltage differences.
- 2.3 Check the operation of battery system in accordance with NAMC YS-11 Maintenance Manual or NAMC YS-11A Maintenance Manual 24-30-0 " Operation Test of Battery System " section.
