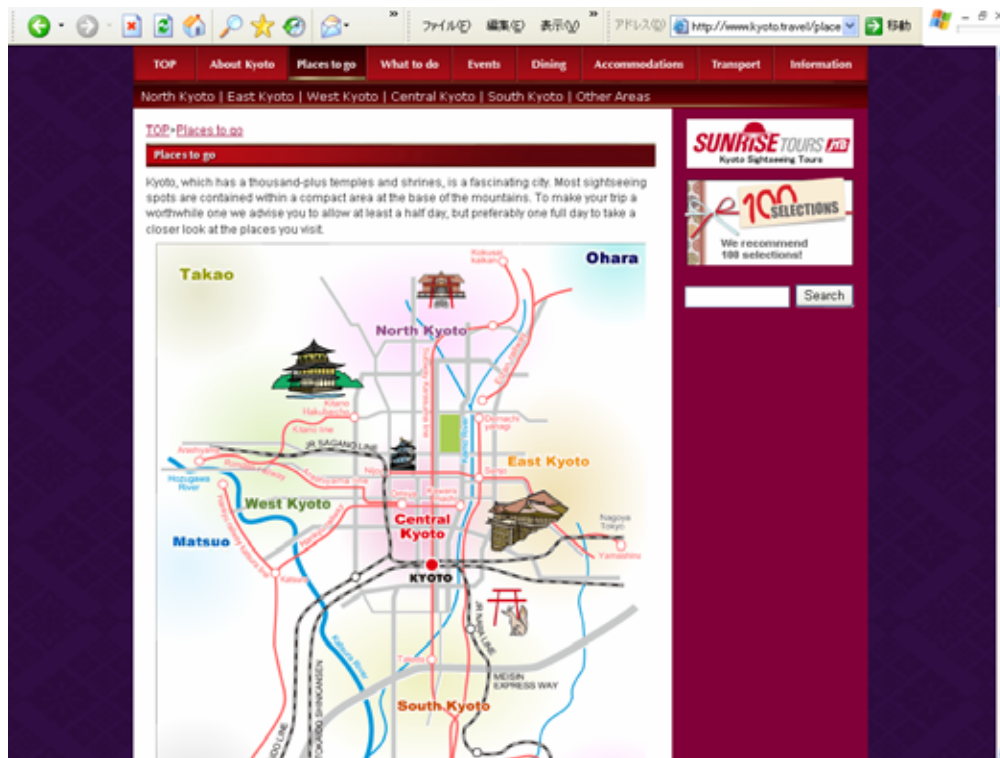

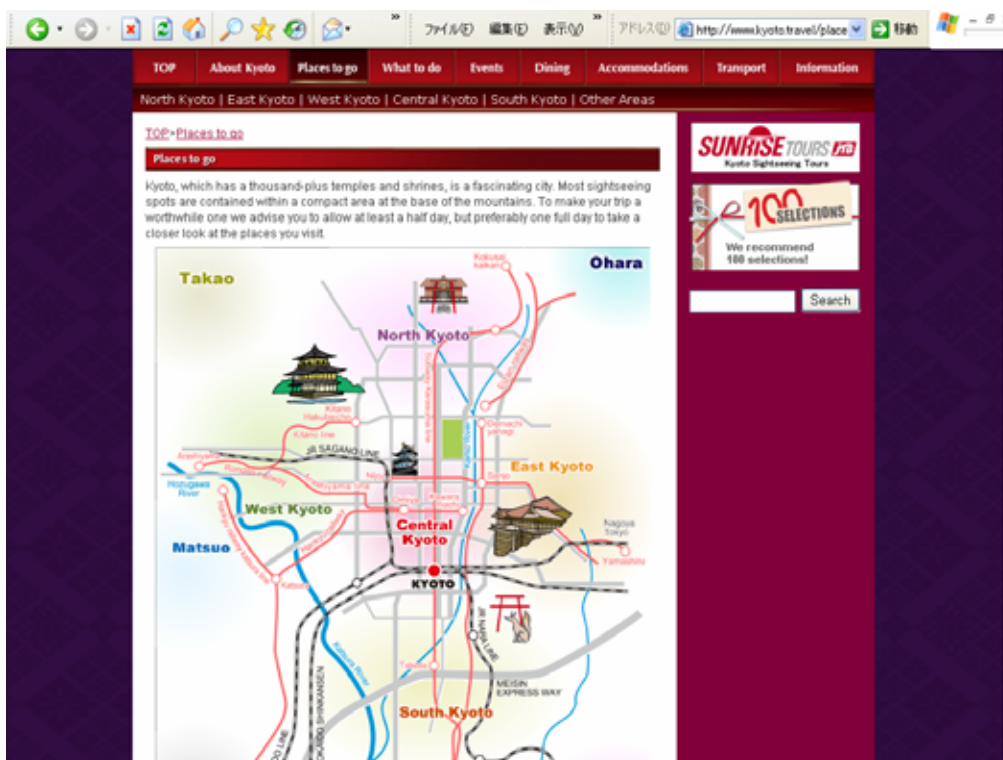

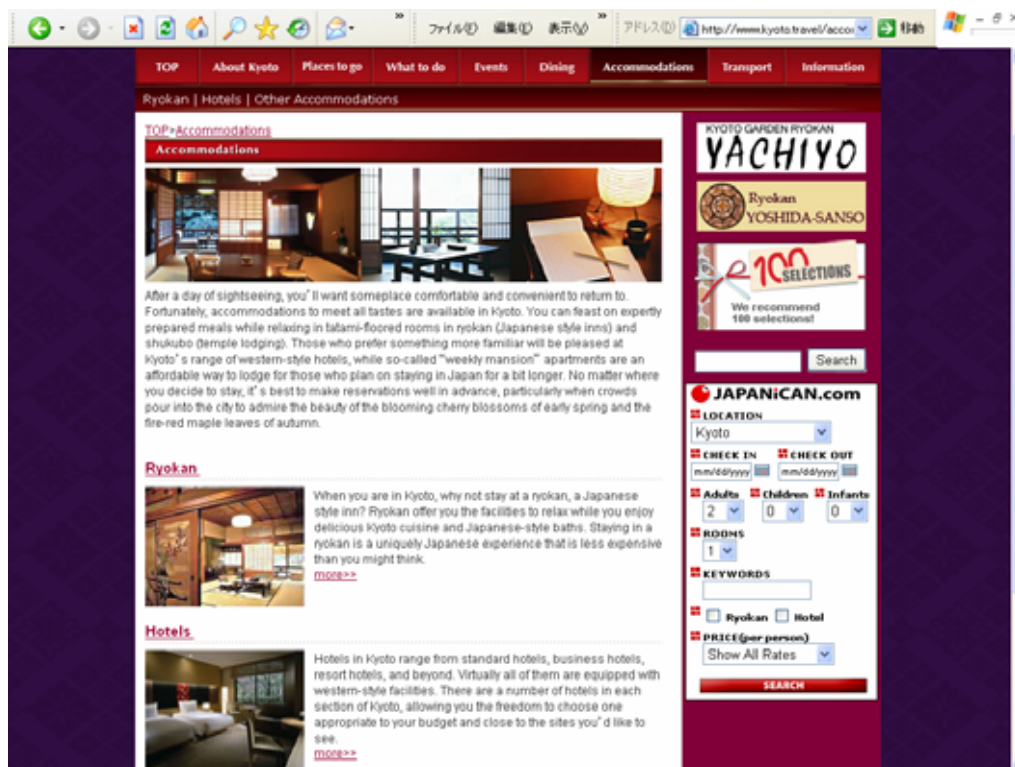

No matter where you decide to stay, it's best to make reservations well in advance, particularly when crowds pour into the city to admire the beauty of the blooming cherry blossoms of early spring and the fire-red maple leaves of autumn.

Ryokan(traditional inns)

Kyoto has a wide range of accommodation to suit all budgets, from the finest ryokan, or traditional inns, to youth hostels, guesthouses and shukubo, or temple lodgings. Needless to say, there are also plenty of western-style hotels, from inexpensive business hotels to first-class luxury hotels. Bear in mind that much of Kyoto's accommodation can be booked up during the April cherry-blossom season and late October to late November, when the fall foliage is at its height.

Whatever you do come, try to reserve as early as possible if you plan to be in town during these times. Credit cards are accepted at most hotels, but don't expect to pay with plastic at budget places. At ryokan, the higher the price, the better the chance of being able to use a credit card. In this guide, cheap sleeps are rooms that cost JPY6,000 or less, mid-range rooms cost between JPY6,000 and JPY15,000, and high-end rooms cost more than JPY15,000.

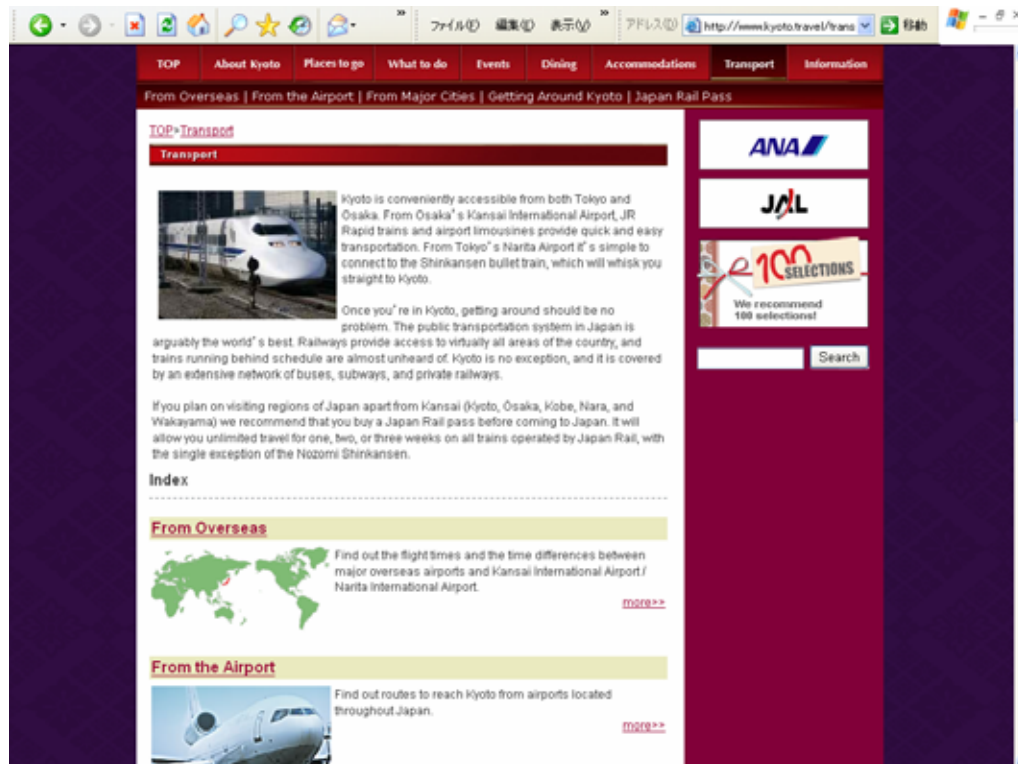

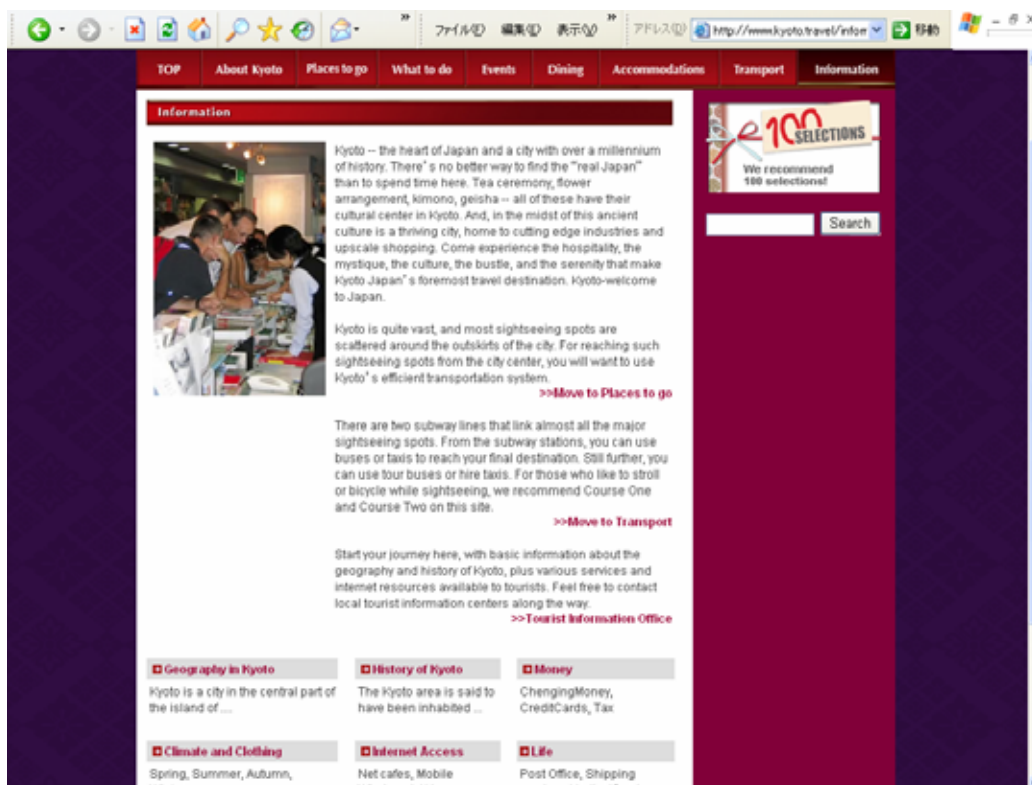

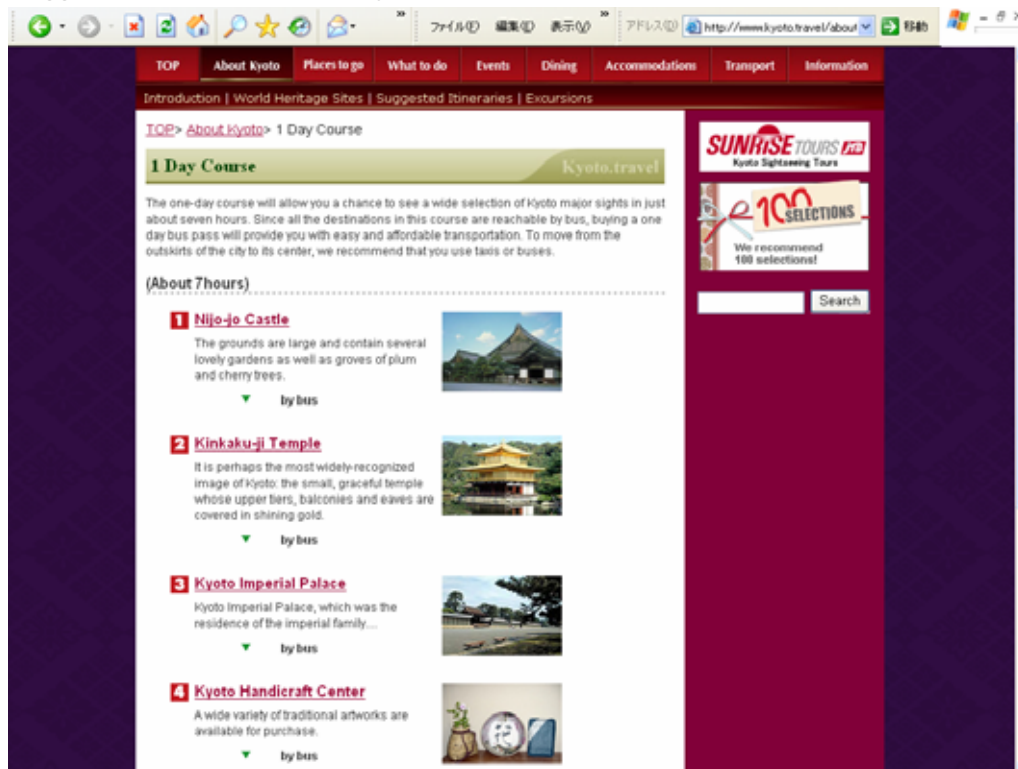
