## The 19th Japan-Korea Road Meeting (Report)

--- Technological Exchange between Japan and Korea in the Roads Sector ---

The Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism (MLIT) and the Ministry of Land Infrastructure and Transport (MOLIT) held the 19th Japan Korea Road Meeting on August 31st. In this meeting, we exchanged knowledge concerning the latest initiatives in the road sector, expressway policy, and road management, and confirmed the continuous exchange of technology between Japan and Korea.

An agreement "Implementing Arrangement for the Holding of the Japan-Korea Road Exchange Conference" was made in 1995 to hold a Japan-Korea Road Meeting, to promote cooperation in the field of road technologies between the two countries.
