




Structure of the World Forum






Parties to the 1958 and 1998 Agreements

World Forum WP.29 Current projects in development

- A. Worldwide harmonized emission test procedures, including the measurement of CO2 emissions
- B. Introduction of fuel market quality standards, including bio-fuels
- C. Development of Environmentally Friendly Vehicles (EFV)



Expectations from MEET

- Development of common understanding for global efforts on environmental and energy measures in the transport sector :
- WP.29 as the catalyser for vehicles technical deliberations and encourage it to continue the development of harmonized vehicle regulations
- Understand the importance of the development of a worldwide measurement cycle of CO2 vehicle emissions to have a unique worldwide method
