Description of defect	<p>A concern has been identified with 2010 and Model Year XK and XF vehicles whereby the Power Assisted Steering (PAS) pipes have been supplied with zinc-nickel plating that does not meet fully the corrosion protection requirements of Jaguar's engineering specification.</p> <p>After an extended period of time in service, corrosion of the PAS pipes will occur, this may lead to pin-holing of the pipe. Pin-holing of PAS pipes could allow pressurized PAS fluid to leak into the under-hood and engine bay area. Loss of PAS fluid will cause PAS system noise and loss of power assisted steering; steering control is fully maintained in an unassisted state. It is also possible that the PAS fluid may ignite if it comes into contact with an ignition source or a surface at sufficiently high enough temperature.</p>
