# **Aeronautical Consultations between Japan and Mongolia**

The consultations between the aeronautical authorities of Japan and Mongolia were held in Tokyo, Japan, on 20 and 21 November 2013. The outline of the meeting is as follows:

#### 1. Delegations

From the Japanese side, Mr. Taro Kobayashi, Director of the Air Talks Office, Civil Aviation Bureau, Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism (Delegation Head), and other representatives attended the meeting.

From the Mongolian side, Mr. Baasandorj Batzaya, State Secretary of the Ministry of Roads and Transportation of Mongolia (Delegation Head), and other representatives attended the meeting.

### 2. Summary of the Outcome

- (1) Frequency increase at Narita International Airport is expected from current five (5) flights a week to seven (7) flights a week by the airlines of Mongolia.
- (2) More flexible code sharing framework was established from the standpoint of expanding operational flexibility for the airlines of Japan and Mongolia.
