DESCRIPTION OF DEFECT	Bolts that fasten drive plate and torque converter may become loose and drop off due to insufficient fastening torque on vehicles with Continuously Variable Transmission (CVT) or Automatic Transmission (AT). That leads to abnormal noise and in the worst case, the dropped bolts can be bitten by the drive plate and cylinder block, ending up to possible engine stalling and unable engine restart.
