The 7th Japan-Korea Aviation Cooperation Conference

The 7th Japan-Korea Aviation Cooperation Conference was held on Nov. 28th (Thurs.) & 29th (Fri.) in Busan City, South Korea, between aeronautical authorities of Japan and South Korea. The Japanese delegation was led by Hiroshi Otsuka, Assistant Vice-Minister for International Affairs and International Aviation, Minister's Secretariat, and The South Korean delegation was led by Mr. Suh Hoon-taik, Director General for Aviation Policy, Ministry of Land, Infrastructure and Transport.

During the Conference, both parties have exchanged information and views on the following issues and agreed that the two countries will continue to cooperate in all fields of aviation on a broad scale.

- ④ ATM (Air Traffic Management) Challenges
