Official Announcement on "Implementation Policy on Operation of Specified Business at Sendai Airport"

Civil Aviation Bureau of Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism (MLIT) will implement the "Operation of Specified Business" at Sendai Airport aiming at the activation of the Tohoku Region by expanding inflow and outflow of population. This effort will be achieved through the revitalization of Sendai Airport and its surrounding areas through the operations of the runways and terminal buildings in efficient and integrated manners, utilizing the capital and management skills of the private sector.

With the goal of achieving this, we have formulated the Implementation Policy pursuant to the Act on the Promotion of Private Finance Initiative (Act No.117 of 1999, Article 5-1) and the Act on the Operation of the Government-Owned Airports utilizing the Ability of the Private Sector (Act No.67 of 2013, Article 5-2), therefore, we have released the Implementation Policy pursuant to the Act on Promotion of PFI, Article 5-3, and we will accept opinions from private enterprises.
