Notification of Serious Incident

On Apr. 28, 2014, Peach Aviation Airbus A320-214, Registration # JA802P, Flight # APJ252 departed from New Ishigaki Airport at 11:02am for Naha Airport and GPWS was activated while approaching for landing at Naha Airport. Its crew executed an urgent avoidance operation to avert a crash into the water and landed safely at the airport at 12:10pm.
