Status quo
Water pollution load is increasing due to the industrialization and urbanization in Asia. Sewage system coverage is under 5% in the most of countries in this area.

Increasing pollution load due to rapid urbanization and industrialization

Considering the gap between the target and the current status, it is necessary to resolve the common challenges of Asian countries to achieve the goal by 2030.

Gap

- Low priority of wastewater management
- Lack of knowledge and information
- Lack of budget and appropriate technology

Objective 1

Raising Awareness on Wastewater Management

- 1.1 Cross partnership/collaboration (Government, NGO, Private Sector & Media) needed to support one another in raising public awareness on WWM to beneficiaries and affected with simple economical smart means.
- 1.2 Promoting function and importance of wastewater management of responsible officials/chiefs/managers in both soft and hard mechanisms such as
 - Laws, regulations, sub-decree, decisions or instructions etc
 - Drainage/Sewerage System, technologies, Pumping Station and WWTP/STP.
 - Attitude/behavior change, sanitation, hygiene education and communication by disclosure the positive and negative impacts from WWM.

Objective 2

Monitoring of Wastewater Management

- 2.1 Develop PMF (Project Monitoring Framework) including Checklist/Check sheet for work progress with agreed indicators and assumptions
- 2.2 Prepare semester and annual reporting of the work progress with common format
- 2.3 Discuss on challenges, issues, opportunities and solutions
- 2.4 Regular information exchanging/sharing with partner countries, supporting institution and relevant bodies
- 2.5 Record the good practice and solutions

Objective 3

Resolving Common Challenges

- 3.1 Weak planning, design, technologies and implementation capacity building and seeking collaboration with DPs
- 3.2 Seeking experiences of similar challenges & solutions from partner countries of AWaP concerning to funding's constraints for investment and operation
- 3.3 Improving and strengthening institutional and legal framework
