DESCRIPTION OF DEFECT	TK Holdings Inc. ("Takata") has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in the passenger-side frontal airbag inflators installed as original equipment in certain 2007-2014 model year Cadillac Escalade, Chevrolet Silverado 1500 and Tahoe; certain 2012-2014 model year Escalade ESV vehicles; certain 2007-2008 and 2011-2012 model year Chevrolet Avalanche vehicles; certain 2008-2014 model year Chevrolet Silverado 2500/3500 vehicles; certain 2007-2012 model year Chevrolet Suburban vehicles; certain 2008 and 2012 model year GMC Yukon vehicles; and certain 2012 model year Cadillac Escalade EXT, GMC Sierra 1500, Sierra 2500/3500, Yukon XL vehicles. The determination was made that the propellant in these inflators may degrade after long-term exposure to high humidity and temperature cycling, which could cause the inflator to rupture during a deployment. An inflator rupture may cause metal fragments to pass through the airbag and into the vehicle interior at high speed, which may result in injury or death to vehicle occupants.
