

Memorandum of Cooperation
between
<the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare of Japan>
and
<the Ministry of Industry & Handicraft of
the Kingdom of Cambodia>
regarding
Cooperation on Sustainable Water Supply in
the Kingdom of Cambodia

This Memorandum of Cooperation (hereinafter referred to as the “MoC”) constitutes the shared recognition between < the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare of Japan > and < the Ministry of Industry & Handicraft of the Kingdom of Cambodia > (hereinafter collectively referred to as “the Sides”) on the following points regarding cooperative activities to promote sustainable water supply in the Kingdom of Cambodia (hereinafter referred to as “Cambodia”).

1. Principle of Cooperation

The Sides have made an effort to expand water supply facilities and safe water supply in Cambodia. The Sides will carry out the following activities aiming for self-reliant development on the water supply sector in Cambodia based on the National Strategic Development Plan of the Kingdom of Cambodia on the basis of good relationship.

- (i) The Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare of Japan will provide relevant experiences and technologies that contributed to the achievement of high water coverage rate and sustainable water supply in Japan in order to promote the optimal dissemination of water supply in Cambodia.
- (ii) The areas of the cooperative activities under the MoC will be the urban areas in all provinces of Cambodia.
- (iii) To achieve the objectives of the MoC, the knowledge of public and private sector will be utilized and the cooperation between both sectors will be promoted.

2. Implementation

All activities under the MoC will be carried out in accordance with laws and regulations of the Sides. The activities may be carried out to the extent of human, financial and other resources.

The activities under the MoC will be implemented by cooperating with the City of Kitakyushu of Japan, which has a track record of international cooperation for enhancing water service in Cambodia, after the signature of the MoC.

Any differences of views on the implementation of this MoC will be settled amicably through consultations between the Sides.

3. Duration

The cooperation under the MoC will commence upon signature by the Sides and will continue for five (5) years.

4. Modification

This MoC may be modified by common recognition by the two sides.

5. Language

This MoC was signed in two original copies in the English language.
