

Information Sharing for Aerodrome Operation

Information for aerodrome operation is provided by ATS Flight Information Officers as aerodrome total management service.

(This service is only applied for the aerodrome that managed and operated by State.)

- (1) Collect and manage the information necessary for aerodrome operation, and share with aircraft operators and stakeholders by the site.
- (2) Collect and manage the information on accident, unusual situations, equipment failure and natural disaster, etc. (hereinafter referred to as "contingency case") and provide to the aerodrome director, aircraft operators and stakeholders as necessary.
- (3) Support for the aerodrome director and responsible sections when the contingency case has occurred.
- (4) Initial response, such as communication and coordination, in cases of incidents that may affect the aerodrome operation at the night time, early morning or holidays. (When the responsible sections are not stay at the aerodrome.)
- (5) Contact point of the aerodrome operation which related to the multiple section.
