

## **Memorandum of Cooperation**

### **in the Field of Tourism**

#### **between**

#### **the Japan Tourism Agency**

#### **and**

#### **The Ministry of Foreign Trade and Tourism of the Republic of Peru**

The Japan Tourism Agency and the Ministry of Foreign Trade and Tourism of Peru (hereinafter referred to as “both sides”) have expressed their desire to strengthen the friendly relations between the citizens of their respective States, and have put forward the following proposals with the aim of facilitating economic development and increasing the tourism potential of both countries.

### **Section 1**

#### **Exchange of Information in the Field of Tourism Development**

- Both sides will work together to increase the number of tourists between both countries.
- Both sides will strengthen direct contact activities between tourism authorities in order to develop tourism exchange between both countries.
- Both sides will cooperate in the development of sustainable tourism.
- Both sides will promote the sharing of information on science, technology, and innovation applied to tourism.
- Both sides will exchange information on knowledge and experiences relating to the utilization and conservation of natural and cultural resources.

### **Section 2**

#### **Cooperation in the field of human resources development and skills upgrading for the tourism industry**

Both sides will cooperate to facilitate information exchange and expert interactions between organizations of their respective States with the objectives of educating and developing human resources and improving their skills.

### **Section 3**

#### **Resolution of Differences**

Any differences between both sides arising out in the interpretation, application and implementation of this Memorandum of Cooperation will be settled amicably through consultations or negotiations between both sides.

### **Section 4**

#### **Modifications**

Both sides may propose a revision or modification of this Memorandum of Cooperation. Such revision or modification will require the mutual written consent of both sides.

### **Section 5**

#### **Final Part**

This Memorandum of Cooperation will have a duration of five (5) years from the date of its signature and, unless either side gives notification in writing to the other side of its intention to discontinue it at least six (6) months before the end of the five-year duration, will be automatically extended for a further five (5) year period. Discontinuation will not affect the implementation of the programs, projects, or joint activities planned under this Memorandum of Cooperation.

This Memorandum does not constitute an international treaty nor does it impose legally binding rights or obligations on both sides, or their respective States.

This Memorandum of Cooperation will commence on the date of its signature.

This Memorandum of Cooperation is signed in the city of Tokyo, on this 8th day of August 2025, in two originals, each in the English language.
