## Kehi Shrine

Main Attractions

Kehi Shrine, believed to date back to 702, is a time-honored sanctuary also known as the "primary shrine of Echizen province" and a "tutelary of the Hokuriku Road." Legend says the 10.9-meter tall torii gate was made from a Temple Juniper that drifted from Sado Island in Niigata. Along with the wooden gates of Hiroshima's Itsukushima Shrine and Nara's Kasuga Grand Shrine, it is designated an Important Cultural Property of Japan.

Yokokan was the mansion of the Matsudaira clan of the Fukui domain. The elegant building, designed around a study and the vast expanse of garden, are noted as precious remaining examples of mid-Edo period architecture. For the beauty of the garden and its harmony with the building, Yokokan Garden is designated a place of scenic beauty in Japan. In 2023 it ranked ninth in a list of Japanese gardens compiled by an American magazine.

## Fukui Prefectural Varve-museum

"Varve" are striped geological formations that have been deposited over 70,000 years in Lake Suigetsu, one of the five lakes of mikata, and are considered to be the world's standard yardstick for measuring the age of fossils and archaeological artifacts, which is unique in the world. A real specimen about 45 meters long is on display, and you can easily learn about the Earth's past climate change.

## Five Lakes of Mikata

Main Attractions

The Five Lakes of Mitaka—Lake Mitaka, Lake Suigetsu, Lake Suga, Lake Kugushi, and Lake Hiruga—each represents a subtly different shade of blue that appears mystical from above. The contrast is clear from the 11.2-kilometer long road Rainbow Line, which offers a dynamic view of the lakes against the Sea of Japan. In November 2005 the site was covered by the Convention on Wetlands of International Importance (Ramsar Convention).

## Ichijodani Asakura Clan Ruins

The Warring States-era warlords, the Asakura clan, ruled this area from 1471 to 1574; the remains of their castle town can still be seen today. These remains have been designated a special historic site, a site of special scenic beauty, and an important cultural property. The restored town scenery of samurai residences and townhouses was reconstructed using the foundation stones and stone fences just as they were found underground on the site.

Eiheiji is a main temple of the Soto sect of Zen Buddhism. It was founded by Dogen Zenji as a training monastery 0770 years ago, in 1244. Bordered on three sides by mountains and situated deep in a forest of 700-year-old Japanese cedar trees, the premises are lined with some 70 buildings large and small. The temple is listed in the 100 Historic Landscapes of Beauty in Japan.

The Tsuruga Port was the only one in Japan open to Polish orphans from Siberia in 1920 and to Jewish refugees with "visas for life" issued by Chiune Sugihara, Vice Consul for the Empire of Japan in Lithuania in 1940. Dubbed the "Harbor of the East" and later the "Port of Humanity," Tsuruga has flourished for a long time as a gateway to continental Asia.
