Kintoki Mikan mandarin oranges, Kintoki Ninjin carrots, and Kintoki Imo sweet potatoes are Sakaide's local specialties. Their features are in their bright red color and high content of sugar. Kintoki Mikan are in season from late November to early January Kintoki Ninjin and Kintoki Imo are harvested from November to March, and from late June to late August respectively. There are other products made from the Three Kintoki, such as jams and puddings that you can buy as souvenirs.

Seto Ohashi Bridge Commemorative Park was constructed in commemoration of the completion of the Seto Ohashi Bridge. The park is conveniently located under the bridge, which affords a nice viewpoint where you can closely see the impressive bridge. Within the 10.2 ha (25.2 acre) large park, you will find the Seto Ohashi Bridge Commemorative Hall, which exhibits the history of the bridge, along with The Lawn Plaza and The Water Corridor, where fountain was designed to reflect the beautiful image the bridge. The park is popular with local families as well as tourists.

At the Kagawa Prefectural Higashiyama Kaii Setochi Museum, you can view both the Great Seto Bridge and about 350 print works of the Great Japanese Painting Master Kaii Higashiyama. His grandfather was from Hitsuishi Island in Sakaide City. This small prefectural art museum is located in the Shami area, overlooking Hitsuishi Island, thebirthplace of his grandfather to celebrate the association between Higashiyama and Kagawa prefecture.

Having been banished from the court following his defeat in the Hogen Rebellion in 1156, the 75th Emperor Sutoku died in exile in Sakaide in 1164 at the age of 46. There are many places in the city where you can trace his footsteps around the city, such as the Shiraminegoryo Mausoleum, the only mausoleum in the Shikoku District.

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Shamijima Island

Main Attractions

Shamijima Island was connected by landfill to the mainland of Sakaide after the Bannosu reclamation project in 1967. There is a poem monument related to the manyo poet "Kakinomoto no Hitomaro" as well as old ruins connected to Priest Rigen Daishi, one of the "Great Five Daishi Priests in Sanuki (Kagawa)." In 2013 and 2016, this location became part of the Setouchi Triennale (art festival) and this is a destination where you can fell the art. This is the scenic viewpoint where you can enjoy a breathtaking view of the Seto Ohashi Bridge and the islands on the Seto Inland Sea.

Seto Ohashi Bridge





The Seto Ohashi Bridge is two-tiered, combined road bridge and railway bridge which connects the main island of Honshu to Shikoku Island. The bridge opened to traffic in April 1988 and it is the world largest class with 9.4km long over the strait. It connects the islands of Shiwaku Shoto with 6 sections of the bridge. On Sunny days, you can enjoy the picturesque besuty of the nature of the Seto Iuland Sea which is resonated by the bridge and you can also enjoy panoramaic View of the Bridge which is brightly lit as night on Saturdays and national holidays.

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Sakaide on-the-sea Fireworks Display of the Sakaide

Held every August, the Sakaide Ohashi Festival is the biggest festival in the city. Among the variety of events held during this festival, fireworks are launched from the sea with the Seto Ohashi Bridge in the background, and the lights reflected on the surface of water are bright and beautiful. The prefecture's largest-class Shakudama size fireworks (about 30 cm ball) are shot off 10 at a time, and are overwhelming.
