Senpiro-no-taki Waterfall

Senpiro-no-taki Waterfall flows down a face of a huge granite monolith. The waterfall and the V-shaped gorge with a huge granite outcropping (400×200 meters) create a breathtaking view. The waterfall is about 60 meters in height. On rainy days, you can enjoy the view of the waterfall from an observation deck a little distance away. On sunny days, you can enjoy a relatively easy hike to see a dynamic view of the waterfall from the suspension bridge near the basin of the fall. (480×9)

Some epiphytes such as Yakushima Rhododendron and Japanese Rowans have beautiful flowers during their blooming season.
