Those who can confirm that they have been in Japan for less than six months since their temporary return to Japan.

Requirements	Types of Passports or Documents to Be Presented	Supporting Documents
The individual must be able to verify, with “supporting documents,” that they have continuously maintained an address or residence outside Japan for two years or more.	Passport	<p>“A copy of the Koseki no Fuhyō (Family Register Attachment),” “a Residency Certificate,” or “an Individual Number Card (My Number Card)”</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A Residency Certificate includes both electronically issued certificates (so-called “e-certificates”) and printed versions of such e-certificates. • These supporting documents are not required to show the holder’s registered domicile (honseki). • “My Number Card” includes its digital alternative (the smartphone-based My Number credential) and must indicate that the holder has moved abroad.
