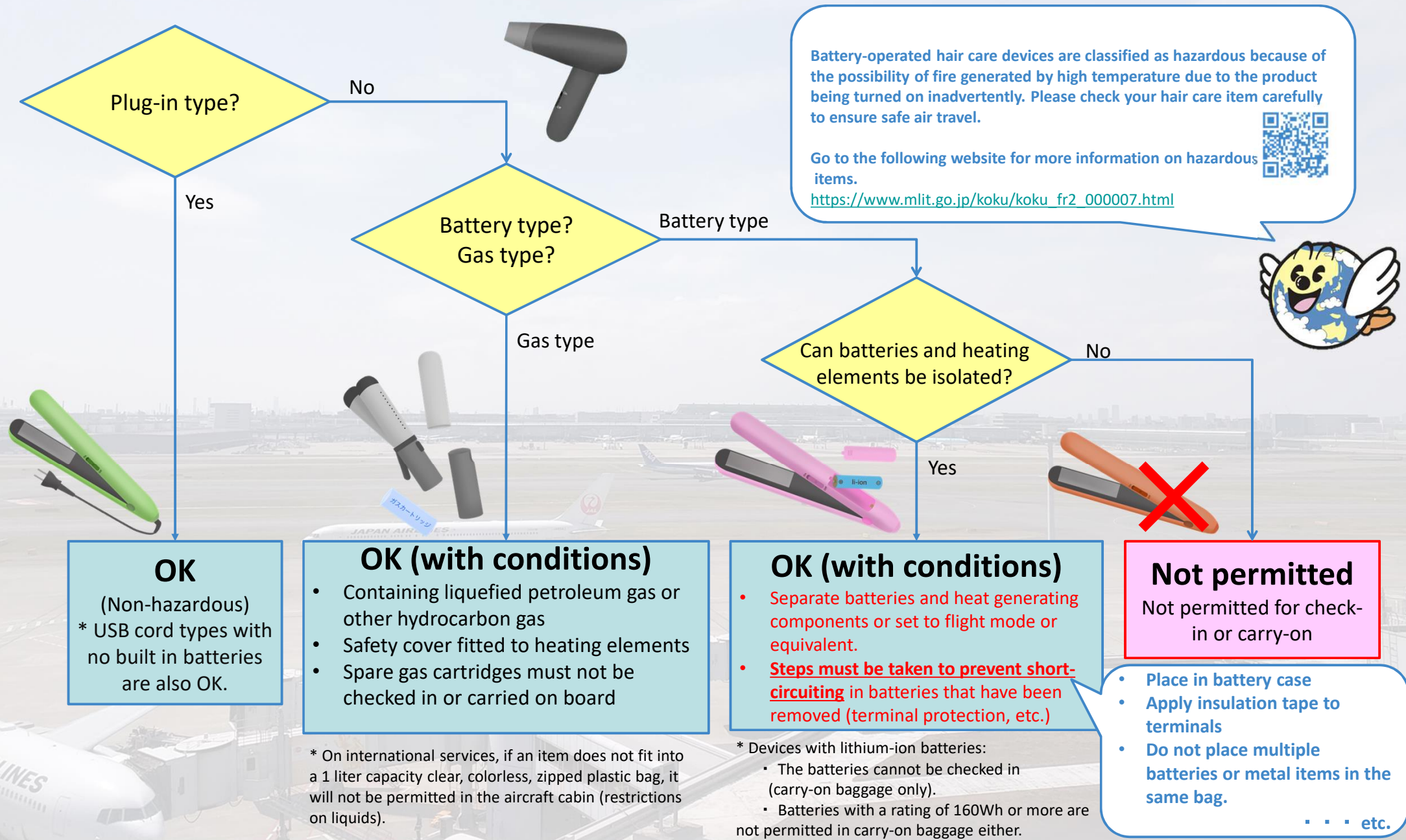


# Attention! Customers purchasing hair care items: Check that your purchase can be taken on board your aircraft!

Some passengers are unaware that the cordless devices they carry on aircraft can be classified as hazardous. If you plan to take a hair iron or hair dryer when traveling, check if the device can be carried in the cabin or checked in.



Battery-operated hair care devices are classified as hazardous because of the possibility of fire generated by high temperature due to the product being turned on inadvertently. Please check your hair care item carefully to ensure safe air travel.

- OK (with conditions)**
- Containing liquefied petroleum gas or other hydrocarbon gas
  - Safety cover fitted to heating elements
  - Spare gas cartridges must not be checked in or carried on board

\* On international services, if an item does not fit into a 1 liter capacity clear, colorless, zipped plastic bag, it will not be permitted in the aircraft cabin (restrictions on liquids).

- OK (with conditions)**
- Separate batteries and heat generating components or set to flight mode or equivalent.
  - Steps must be taken to prevent short-circuiting in batteries that have been removed (terminal protection, etc.)

\* Devices with lithium-ion batteries:

- The batteries cannot be checked in (carry-on baggage only).
- Batteries with a rating of 160Wh or more are not permitted in carry-on baggage either.

**Not permitted**  
Not permitted for check-in or carry-on

- Place in battery case
- Apply insulation tape to terminals
- Do not place multiple batteries or metal items in the same bag.
