


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
- The following changes have been made to the form as of September 2023. For the time being, applications can be submitted using the old form.




- When submitting Form 19 to East Japan Civil Aviation Bureau, payment by revenue stamps using Form 31 is required.

3-1 The Abolition of the Examination Ticket and Issuance of the Application Acceptance Notice



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- The examination ticket will no longer be issued, and instead the application acceptance notice will be sent.
- Identity verification on the day will be done using identification documents specified, so <u>you do</u> not need to bring the application acceptance notice sent by the authorities to the venue.
- The application acceptance notice will be sent out at least 3 business days before the first day of the examination period.

3-2 Communication from the MLIT Headquarters Regarding Detailed Information on the Examination



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- Apart from the notification of acceptance of your application for the examination, the MLIT will contact you at your e-mail address with detailed information about the examination.
- The e-mail will include the meeting place, time, schedule, personal belongings, and precautions to be taken during the examination. Please check the information carefully and arrive at the designated date and time.
- Identification documents for the day of the test are as follows.

3-3 Examination Methods and Examples of Schedules




- Both the examination questions and answer sheets (mark sheets) will be distributed on paper, and you are required to answer the questions using the writing utensils you bring with you.
