URBAN QUALITY



In 2100, **sea level will rise** between 90 cm i 1,80 m. Shoreline erosion in Catalonia is, by average, 90 cm per annum. How can we intervene in our shores to mitigate **shoreline regression**?

In the coming years, predicted deaths due to rising temperatures escalates from 300 persons per year up to 2.500 persons per year.

What kind of actions do cities need to take in order to effectively mitigate the heat island effect?






