

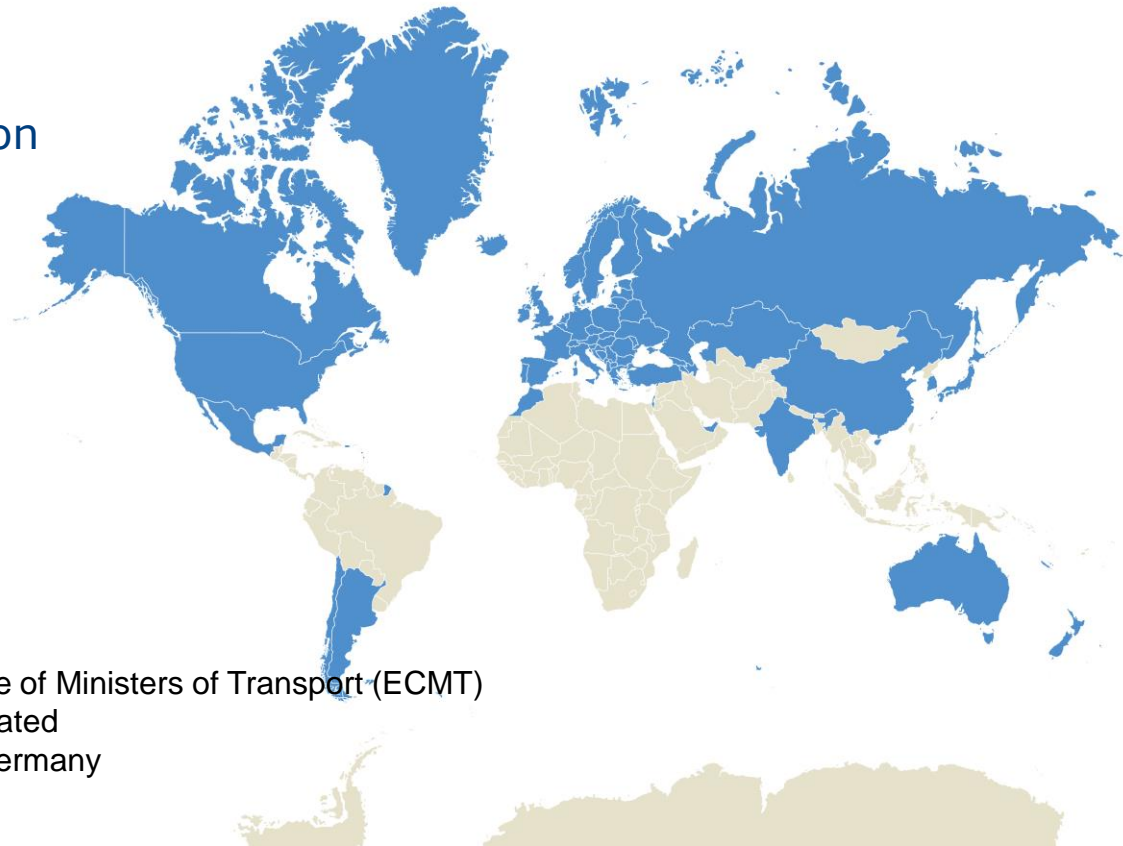

## Safety and Security

- ▶ How are countries moving **towards safer and more secure** transport systems?
- ▶ **Safety:** measures to protect life or goods, to reduce or eliminate risks of accidents/ crashes in all transport modes
- ▶ **Security:** measures to address terrorist attacks, crimes committed on the premises of transport operators, theft of cargo in transit, or cyber threats, piracy on the high seas...

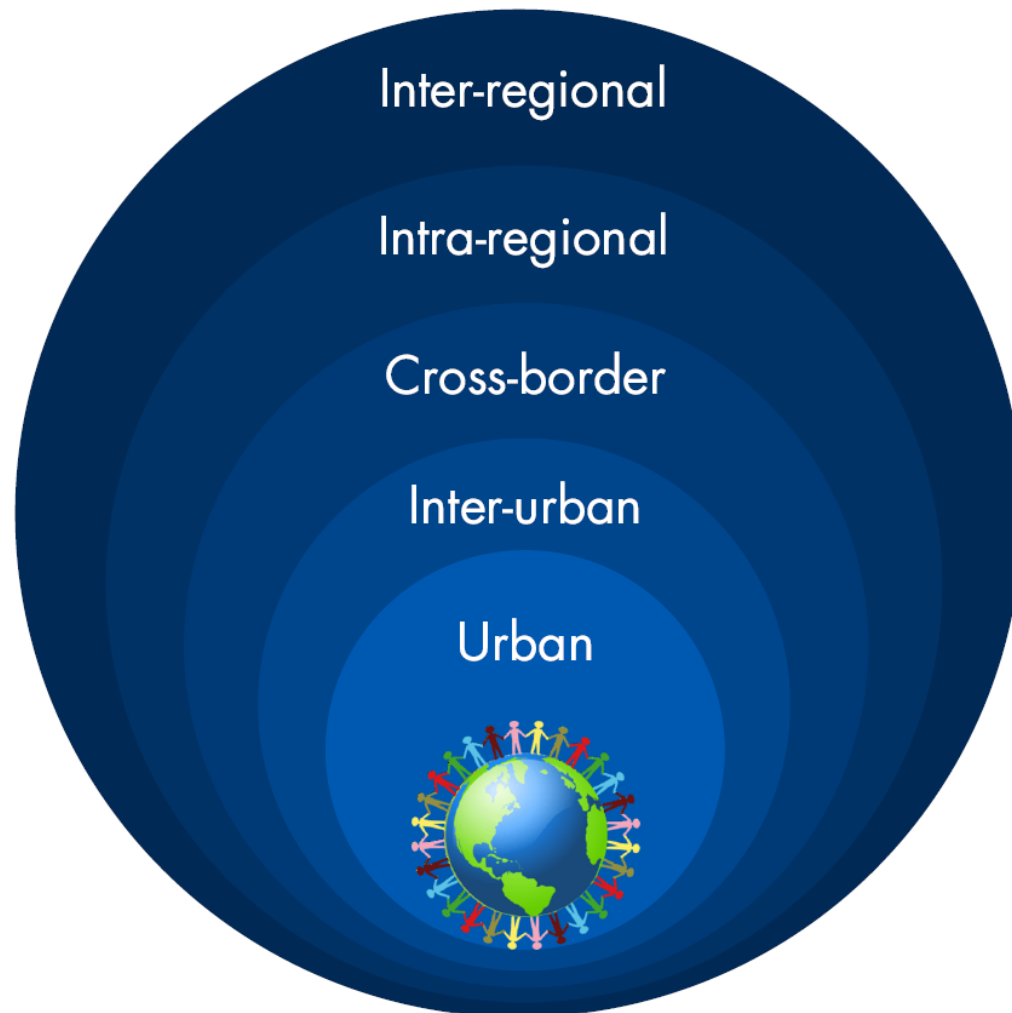
## Context

  - Transport Connectivity for Regional Integration(2019)
  - Transport Innovation for Sustainable Development(2020)
- ▶ Role of transport in meeting the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)

## Transport connectivity

- ▶ Ability and ease with which destinations may be reached from **potential points of departure**
- ▶ Connectivity dimensions: **spatial** and **temporal**
- ▶ All transport modes; **passenger** and **freight transport**

- ▶ Data and statistics
- ▶ Identification of best-practice policies
- ▶ Institutionalised in Transport Research Centre (TRC)
