


Change of Aging rate in Japan and U.S.








Age comparison of the population, Japan vs. U.S. ² 国土交通省









The elderly people hope in-home nursing care














The ratio of social expenditure to GDP(%)

Convenience Stores


- Mobile catering to residences/apartment complex and install temporary shops limited by opening hours and date (Satellite Stores) in residences/apartment complex

 - -Local Government Supporting operation of hubs in apartment complex



Point of View


- Make a system that community is independent assuming residential area
