The 38th Japan-China Road Meeting (Report)

The Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism (MLIT) and the Ministry of Transport of the People's Republic of China (PRC) held “the 38th Japan-China Road Meeting” on September 11, 2024.

In this meeting, we exchanged knowledge concerning “Smart road”, “Utilization of new technologies”, “Disaster management and disaster recovery”. We also confirmed the continuous exchange of technology between Japan and China.

Based on the the agreement for “Japan-China Road Meeting” signed in 1984, this meeting has been held for more than 30 years to advance technical exchanges in the road sector.
