Japan-Indonesia International Conference on Toll Road O&M Technologies

On February 10th, The Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism (MLIT) organized an online "Japan-Indonesia International Conference on Toll Road O&M Technologies" with support of the Ministry of Public Works and Housing in Indonesia.

In this conference, the participants shared the latest situation of toll roads in Indonesia, Japanese technologies and approaches to the operation and maintenance of expressways, and also confirmed that both the public and private sectors will continue to cooperate with each other in this field.

The purpose of this conference was to share the latest efforts in the field of toll road O&M in both Japan and Indonesia, and to strengthen cooperation among the public and private sectors of both countries.
