Planning and conducting self-guards;

Planning and conducting self-guards;

Installation of Fence and monitor; and

Designation of the Security Officer, etc.

Government indicates Maritime Security Levels

Government approves ship security plans and verifies ships

Each ship can engage international voyage with certificate, issued by Government

Government approves port facility security plans

Control the ships entering into ports

- To oblige the ships, coming from foreign countries, to send information to Japan Coast Guard (JCG) prior to entry into the ports.
- To request the ships to send additional information and visit and board, if these additional requests of steps are necessary.
- If the ship denied the additional requests, or if the ship has obvious threat, which may affect on port facilities and there is no effective measure.

JCG may take steps, such as denial of entry into port
