Kushiro Crane Reserve

Kushiro Crane Reserve is an observation and educational facility that protects and breeds redcrowned cranes. Visitors can see various exhibits in the main building, including taxidermies showing the life cycle of the crane. Outside, pairs of cranes and their young live in a 7-hectare enclosure built in the wetlands. The birds can be observed up close through the fence, a particularly special experience in May when new chicks are hatching. Many of the red-crowned cranes live in the reserve year-round.
