Wild Animals Found in Oku-Nikko II

There is a greater chance of seeing certain wild mammals in Oku-Nikko, notably deer and monkeys, as their populations continue to grow. Japanese badgers (*Meles anakuma*), martens (*Martes melampus*), and raccoon dogs (*Nyctereutes procyonoides*) can also be observed beside roads and wooden walkways in the park. Visitors are requested not to disturb the wildlife and not to feed the animals.
