

Etonupu (Pitcher), Tuki (Alcohol Cup), and Kasup (Ladle)

The traditional alcoholic drink known as *tonoto* is made from fermented rice and millet. The *etonupu*, like the one on display here, is used as a vessel for serving *tonoto* during religious ceremonies. The drink is transferred from its storage container to the *etonupu* and then to the *kasup*. It is then poured into smaller cups, known as *tuki*, from which the participants drink.
